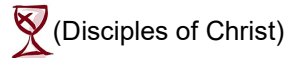

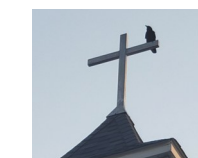

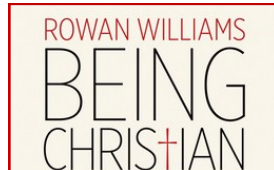

Our youth are going to Give Kids the World (GKTW) in Orlando from June 1st to June 8<sup>th</sup>. Many of you have asked, "Why GKTW?" The answer begins with a man named Henri Landwirth (Henri's bio: <https://www.gktw.org/about/henri-landwirth.php>), and his vision behind GKTW (<https://www.gktw.org/about/>). This place was created to give a magical experience with a vacation that means the world to children with critical illnesses and their families.

Our youth group will spend a week down there, helping these families make memories that will need to last a lifetime. Serving meals in their cafeteria or taking it to their villa. Operating the rides and other attractions at GKTW. We are living out Matthew 25:40, "Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me."

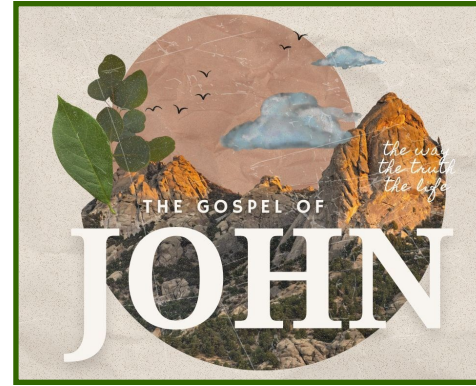

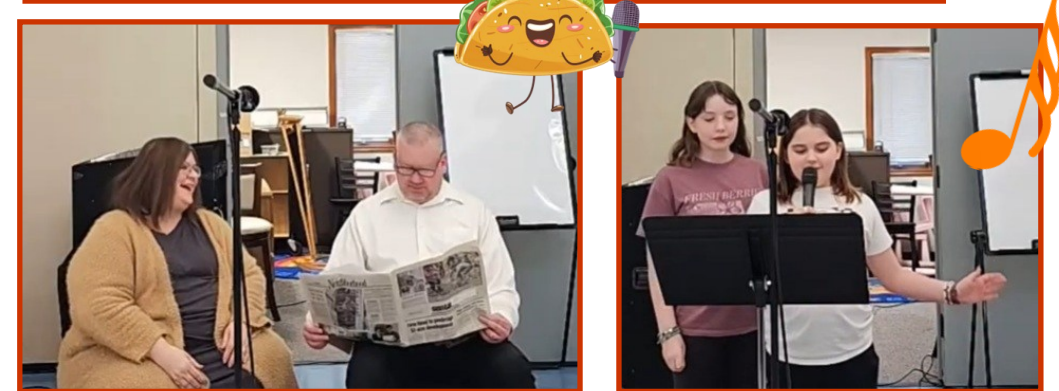
