



Dear Church,

We'll take on a different way of life this month as we enter the season of Lent. Together, we'll seek to encounter Jesus in ways that invite him into the deepest parts of our lives. To lead us on this journey, we'll begin a new sermon series on Sunday the 22nd called "One-on-One With Jesus." For seven Sundays, we'll spend time in *The Gospel of John* to explore the one-on-one encounters people had with Jesus and how their lives were forever changed.

We'll begin with Jesus' first words in *The Gospel of John*, a probing question that will set the tone for Lent: "What do you seek?" Each week we'll spend time with someone new: Jesus' first disciples, Nicodemus, the Samaritan woman at the well, a man born blind, Mary, Martha, and Pilate. Finally, on Easter Sunday we'll spend time with Peter as he reconciles with Jesus over breakfast on the beach. In the end as in the beginning, Jesus calls to them: "Follow me."


These marvelous stories in *John's Gospel* are of a decent length and have incredible depth. Because of this, we'll read just a portion of most of these stories on Sundays. So that you get the whole story each week, you'll need to prepare ahead of time by following along with the reading schedule that's included in this newsletter. If you want to dig even deeper, you can join me Wednesday nights to discuss the Scriptures and sermon from the previous Sunday.

I pray that through these encounters at home and at church you will encounter Jesus and follow him in the here and now.

Youth Service Project


Again, Jesus said, “Peace be with you!

Many kids have a strong desire to be involved in making the world a better place. The youth at Mt. Summit share that feeling and want to be more involved in giving back to our community. Inspired by another youth group, we are undertaking a hands-on community service project that will allow us to do just that, and we want to invite the rest of the congregation to participate.

This simple, yet powerful, project aims to help the less fortunate in our community. These people often do not have easy access to many of the basic necessities we take for granted each day—clean water, food to eat, and a clean body. To help fill these needs, we are putting together Blessing Bags. Contained in each gallon-sized bag will be items such as a bottle of water, peanut butter crackers, dried fruit, a granola bar, beef jerky, a rain poncho, tissues, a toothbrush, toothpaste, mouthwash, a bar of soap, deodorant, wet wipes, hand sanitizer, and lip balm.

The idea is to take a bag and store it in your car. The next time you come across someone in need, don’t drive by! Stop and hand them a Blessing Bag, talk with them (pray with them), invite them to church. Small acts of kindness can mean the world to these people who don’t have much and are so often overlooked or ignored by those who pass by.

We invite you to join us in this service project. If you would like to take a bag, please see James on Sunday mornings. You may also contribute items or funds to this service project—place a check in the offering plate (be sure to write “Youth Blessing Bags” on the memo line).
