



Dear Church,

I was driving home from a Bible Study gathering on a recent Wednesday night and I was overwhelmed by a feeling of gratitude. I was grateful for the people that had gathered with me that evening. I was grateful for the experience we shared. In response to *The Gospel of Matthew*, people gave their presence, appreciation, attention, questions, insights, and experiences in loving ways. God's Spirit was at work that evening. I was simply thankful to be a part of it. If I could put my thumb on it with one word, I would say it was life-giving.

Have you ever been overwhelmed with gratitude? When was that? What was it about?

This led me to think about the Apostle Paul's practice in writing to churches:

- "I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus..." (1 Cor 1:4)
- "I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers..." (Eph 1:16)
- "We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you, since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love that you have for all the saints..." (Col 1:3-4)
- "I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now..." (Philippians 1:3-5)
- And so he commands: "First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and *thanksgivings* be made for everyone..." (1 Tim 2:1)

Do you see a pattern? Do you see a life-giving practice?

Today, I want you to know that I thank God for *you*. Today, I want you to know that I thank God for *our church*. Let's follow Paul's example together. Let's pray and express our thankfulness to God and one another. Today, let's practice what is life-giving.


