

Dear Church,

I want to let you in on a secret. Have you noticed that preachers tend to speak about big ideas, instead of how to do things? Have you noticed that preachers tend to say "we" and "us" instead of "you"? It's easy to talk about bullet points, but not get down to the nitty gritty. It's easy to talk to everyone, but nobody in particular. Many preachers have been trained to talk these ways. Preachers are taught to speak so that everyone can "listen in" on the conversation, instead of addressing people directly. Preachers are taught to speak so that their congregants don't feel singled out and they don't get in trouble. In these ways, preachers leave it up to their listeners to figure out what the message might mean and have to do with them.

If a church stuck to these practices, what would the results be? Would the people be challenged? Would the church make disciples of Jesus? Or would that church go in another direction?

This month we are in the middle of a new teaching series called "Making The Gospel Real." We will ask big questions about following Jesus. But more than that, we will talk about how following Jesus shapes our daily lives. These questions and applications may directly challenge your basic beliefs and daily actions. I hope they will. I hope you are open to that.

The titles for the sermons are the big questions we'll be asking, and they include:

- 1. "What Has God Done for You?"
- 2. "Why Should You Follow Christ?"
- 3. "How Do You Live in Two Worlds?"
- 4. "How Do You Know What's Right?"
- 5. "How Do You Measure Success?"

Think on these questions this month and join me in prayer: "May I be encouraged to follow Jesus in deeper and wider ways than I've ever imagined."
