Dear Church,

If we want to be a growing church, we must be growing spiritually.

We are also hosting our "Tacos & Talent" event, restarting our Christian Community Youth Rallies, and hosting an Easter Egg Hunt for the Mt. Summit community. March is an exciting month to be involved at Mt. Summit Christian Church. Come grow with us!


