Dear Church,

One evening, my friend and fellow Disciples pastor James Shenko asked me and several friends to participate in an exercise together: "Summarize the Gospel in seven words or less." The goal was to help us clarify our thoughts and witness as Christians.

I turned this question over in my mind that night and came up with multiple answers.

- I thought about 1 Corinthians 15: "Jesus: Christ. Crucified. Risen. Reigning. Reconciling. Renewing."
- I thought about *Mark 1*: "Repent! The Kingdom of God is here."
- I thought about 1 Corinthians 2: "Christ crucified is the power of God."

James and my friends offered up their own answers, including:

- "We screw up. God saves us."
- "Christ has come to heal the world."
- "Die with him. Live with him."

This all led me to my final answer: "There is hope for you in Christ." These seven words struck a deep emotional chord with me. I remembered that this was the good news that changed my life. This was what I needed to hear when I was a teenager when I was all out of hope and couldn't find a way forward.

Are you looking for hope? Are you in need of a way forward? God has a word for you. This month we are spending four Sundays digging into the hope God offered to his people through the prophets of our Holy Scriptures in Habakkuk, Haggai, Isaiah,

and Luke. We'll be peeking behind the curtain to see the transforming vision God offers us in the midst of physical and spiritual desolation. Look on the inside of this newsletter for the sermon schedule so that you can read ahead and dwell on the hope that transforms the world with us.




